A Guided Visit to the Exhibition
Paintings from Siena
Ars Narrandi in Europe's Gothic Age



Join us on Saturday, November 22 for a guided visit of the marvelous exhibition, *Paintings from Siena: Ars Narrandi in Europe's Gothic Age*.

BOZAR pays tribute to Siena and its magnificent pictorial tradition in collaboration with the prestigious Pinacoteca Nazionale di Siena and the Musée des Beaux-Arts de Rouen. Siennese artists developed their own style over time, evolving from the rigid patterns of late-Byzantine iconography to more narrative works of art. The exhibition showcases sixty masterpieces which bear testimony to a revolutionary form of art which, from the thirteenth century until the fifteenth century, took an increasing interest in space and in the exploration of human emotions using brilliant, unusual colors. The Siennese school inspired other arts centers in Italy and finally left its mark all over Europe. A unique opportunity to see these masterpieces in Brussels!

Our guide will once again be Lieve De Jonghe. Please note that this visit is limited to 15 people and is a Members Priority Event. Non-members may sign up after November 12 on a space-available basis.



In Commemoration of the 70th Anniversary of the Battle of the Bulge

December 11, 2014



On December 16, 1944, the Battle of the Bulge began on the Western Front of World War II, and lasted until January 25, 1945, inflicting heavy casualties. During the Siege of Bastogne, despite overwhelming odds, U.S. Brigadier General Anthony McAuliffe responded to a request to surrender the town with the one word answer, “Nuts!” This marked the turning point of the Battle of the Bulge for the American troops and on December 30, 1944, General McAuliffe was awarded the Distinguished Service Cross by General Patton for his actions at Bastogne.

On the occasion of the 70th anniversary of the Battle of the Bulge, the American Club of Brussels invites you to “Nuts!” Night to remember the courage and indomitable spirit of those who sacrificed so much during the Battle of the Bulge. The event features a commemoration ceremony honoring all those who served and made the ultimate sacrifice in order to lay the groundwork for the peace, freedom and friendship we now enjoy.

In the spirit of reconciliation and friendship, the ceremony will include U.S. Ambassador to Belgium Denise Campbell Bauer and representatives of all those affected by the Battle of the Bulge – the Germans, the city of Bastogne, and veterans – friends, allies and former foes who now all stand united as we build on the lessons of the past and address the challenges of the future together.




An Astronaut's Guide to Life on Earth


