

A Guided Visit to the van Doesburg Exhibition



Join us on Saturday, April 30, for a guided visit of the van Doesburg exhibition, one of this year's Europaalia activities.

Travel back to the beginning of the twentieth century with Theo van Doesburg and inhale the revolutionary atmosphere of the avant-garde in the exhibition *Theo van Doesburg: A New Expression of Life, Art and Technology*. Having founded the art movement De Stijl in the Netherlands with Piet Mondrian in 1917, van Doesburg set off across Europe to promote their abstract visual language internationally. In Paris, he encountered the art of the Dadaists and began writing Dadaist poetry himself. In Weimar, he presented his new awareness of beauty to the Bauhaus architects. He travelled around Europe and made his pioneering visual language appear not only in paintings, but also in buildings, furniture and interiors.

Our guide will once again be the excellent Lieve De Jonghe.



Dine-Out at Le Bugatti



Please join us for our May Dine-Out on May 12 in a return engagement to the popular Bugatti restaurant, opened in 1988, and specializing in Brussels and Belgian cuisine. The building had been the garage annex to an Avenue Louise mansion dating from 1885. The family took the name Bugatti inspired by the famous car created by Ettore Bugatti in 1909. The stained glass window is original (1885) and served as a skylight to the workshop. Even though it has since been back-filled, it retains its beautiful illumination. Over the years, the garage has housed carriages, and other horse-drawn vehicles, through to motor vehicles. At the time the drivers and their families lived upstairs. The tiles on the walls are from the period and the frescos are exact reproductions of the originals. The building is full of history, which the owners are committed to preserve in order to impart the atmosphere in which to enjoy the flavors of their "terroir", entirely developed in their home.

Tour of Saint Jacques de Compostelle Route



Join us on Sunday, June 5, for a guided visit of the Saint Jacques de Compostelle route in the center of Brussels. Not to worry – we're not taking you all the way to Spain!

This tour will take us on the footsteps of the pilgrims of Santiago de Compostela across the center of Brussels. About 50 bronze shells will show us the itinerary. Starting in the 10th century, pilgrims from all over Europe went to Santiago de Compostela in Spain to see the alleged tomb of the apostle Saint James. It was one of the most important Christian pilgrimages after Jerusalem and Rome. The pilgrims, coming from the north, stopped in Brussels and entered the city through the Louvain gate.
