

The Ommegang takes place on Friday, July 7. Ommegang (literally "walk-around") is a faithful recreation of a splendid pageant that was first performed in 1549 for Emperor Charles V, his son Philip II, and the knights of the Order of the Golden Fleece.

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Staged at night on the illuminated Grand-Place, the two-hour extravaganza includes flag-throwers, folk dancers, archers, acrobats, jesters, jugglers, fire-eaters, falcon-trainers, folkloric giants, stilt-walkers, and the famous Gilles of Binche. Descendants of the nobility of the time play the roles and wear the coats of arms and sumptuous costumes of their ancestors.

This is a spectacular affair, and one of the biggest festivals in the country. Our dinner evening at La Maison du Cygne offers, literally and figuratively, a window on this amazing event. Bring your camera.



His aunt Agnis Hamm convinces him to make a new beginning by returning to their ancestral home in Newfoundland. He learns deep and disturbing secrets about his ancestors that emerge in strange ways...



Introduction to the Jewish Quarter in Antwerpen



Back by popular demand! Join us on Sunday, September 3rd for a unique walking tour of the Jewish Quarter of Antwerp!

For centuries the history of the Jewish people has been intertwined with the history of Antwerp, but for many, the Jewish Quarter is still a completely unknown community. During our walk, we'll explore the culture and the way of life of the more than 15,000 people who live in the Orthodox Jewish community.

Our guide will walk with us through the Jewish Quarter and explain the history of the Jewish people in Antwerp, the Orthodox community and the influence of the religion on peoples' daily lives. The Orthodox community has a long tradition of handling diamonds, and our walk will take us past the famous Diamond District, where more than 70% of the world's rough diamonds are traded.

As part of the tour, we will visit a Jewish Synagogue where a special guide will greet us. She will show us the Synagogue, but more importantly, she will tell us her personal experience of what it means to be Jewish.

The Hoover Belgium Relief Commemoration (HBRC) Gala

During World War I, 90% of Belgium was occupied by the German Army after a campaign that left many towns in ruin and thousands of civilians executed.

The country's population was starving after a systematic pillage of its resources and foodstuff. The American financier and then head of the U.S. Food Administration, [Herbert Hoover](#) (later President of the USA), was asked to find a safe way to help the Belgian population survive by sending food and necessities without risking them being confiscated by the German occupiers.

He created the Commission for Relief in Belgium which called on donations from wealthy Americans to purchase the needed items. The food was distributed in Belgium through an organization directed by the Belgian financier Emile Francqui, and of which businessmen Ernest Solvay and Emmanuel Janssen were members.

Thanks to the excellent cooperation between Hoover and Francqui, some 6 million tons of food were shipped to Belgium from 1914 till the end of the war in 1918, feeding some 9.5 million citizens.

After the war, remaining funds were used to create the Belgian American Educational Foundation that organizes student exchange programs and fosters friendship and mutual understanding between Belgium and the U.S.

The Hoover Belgium Relief Commemoration Gala will keep the memory of this generous undertaking alive. It is part of the American Club of Brussels' mission to encourage initiatives that bring both communities together and remember mutual endeavors. It also follows up the major exhibition held several years ago in Brussels and the one organized last year in the 'In Flanders Fields Museum' in Ypres.

The HBRC Gala will also be a symbol of continuing Belgo-American friendship in promoting education as a path to peace and democracy.
